Creation of new footways and cycleways through Solihull.

### Our part:

- In collaboration with Balfour Beatty Living Places, CR MacDonald were tasked with creating circa 23 kilometers of new permeable footways and cycleways connecting Warwickshire and Solihull providing safe corridors for commuters to travel to and from their place of work via a greener alternate to motor vehicles and for people to enjoy the leisure aspects of the pathways.

### Our successes:

- Furthering our commitment to BBLP, SMBC and its residents.
- Timely completion of the project linking major towns and outdoor spaces accessible by green modes of transport and the promotion of a healthier lifestyle for all ages.
- Planting of wildflower meadows along the route promoting wildlife observation and creating new habitats.
- Project awarded Green Apple Award in 2022 for helping the environment.
- Early engagement with residents and environmental groups at tender stage.
- Logistical challenges of a long route overcome by a dedicated project delivery team and supply chain eased issues of safe site access and material deliveries.
- Safe working environment for all site operatives working towards zero harm.
