Client Brief

Resurfacing 18,800m² of carriageway construction to improve journey experience for 44,000 vehicles per day on the Warwickshire County Council Highways Network.

Our part:

- MacDonald Surfacing were contracted by Balfour Beatty Living Places to carry out all carriageway surfacing at a specified thickness of 110mm using specialist binders, SAMI layers and a high-performance wearing course.
- Working to a 16-day program, all works were carried out under phased road closures from 20:00 – 5:30.

Our success:

- Our Early Contractor Involvement (ECI) with Balfour Beatty Living Places, Warwickshire County Council and our supply chain ensured scope of work and materials specified met the client brief on delivering a durable and sustainable solution.
- MacDonald Surfacing designed laying plans which allowed all surfacing operations to be complete ahead of schedule.
- 100% of carriageway material excavated on site will be recycled to be used on other projects within the Warwickshire Highways Network.
- Special bus lanes were maintained throughout the site for the whole project duration to allow NHS workers to arrive and leave the local NHS hospital.
- Close collaboration by our delivery team with our supply chain each night minimised disruption to all local road users allowing all TM to be removed on time at the end of each night.
- All work was delivered within the client budget.
